

RELATIONS WITH COMMUNITY AND BUSINESS ORGANIZATIONS

The Board of Education recognizes the importance of the school system establishing and maintaining good relationships with community organizations.

Among the community organizations that have established relations with the district are the Parents Organization (PTSO), area churches, the Youth Commission, private social service organizations such as the Lions Club and the Fish and Game Club, and local business organizations such as the Chamber of Commerce.

The school district shall attempt to keep open communications with these community organizations. In establishing local committees such as the School Improvement Planning Team, the district shall make the effort to include representatives from these organizations.

The Board directs the Superintendent of Schools to ensure that the relationships with various community organizations are maintained, and that opportunities for involvement with these organizations are fostered.
