PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

The Board of Education believes that positive parental involvement is essential to student achievement, and thus encourages such involvement in school educational planning and operations.

At the same time, the Board recognizes the rights of parents to be fully informed regarding all information relevant to their children who participate in school projects and programs (including Title I, Gifted and Talented, and Special Education). The district insures parental involvement in these projects and programs by:

- providing opportunities for parents to meet with program personnel;
- convening an annual meeting about specific programs to which all parents of participating children shall be invited;
- disseminating information about special projects and programs through newsletters and other media;
- providing parents with reports on their children's progress;
- providing such reasonable support for parental involvement activities as parents may request.

The person responsible for any and all such programs and projects shall submit an annual report to the Board including the extent of involvement parents may request.
