BOARD OFFICERS

The President and Vice-President of the Board of Education shall be elected by members of the Board at the annual reorganization meeting in July. *Duties of the President of the Board The* duties of the President of the Board shall be as follows:

- 1. to preside at all meetings of the Board;
- 2. to appoint all standing and ad hoc committees;
- 3. to act as an ex-officio member of all committees;
- 4. to execute all documents on behalf of the Board and may delegate such authority to the Vice President:
- 5. to call special meetings he/she considers necessary or on request of one member of the Board;
- 6. to vote together with other members of the Board;
- 7. to perform the usual and ordinary duties of the office; and
- 8. to, along with the other members, offer resolutions, propose or second motions, resolutions, or nominations, and discuss questions.

Duties of the Vice-President

The Vice President shall perform the duties of the President in his/her absence or by delegation by the President except when specific statutory actions are reserved for the Board President.
