## **SPECIAL MEETINGS**

Special meetings of the Board of Education may be called by the District Clerk at the request of the president or other Board member. Notice of such meetings will be given at least 24 hours before the date of the meeting to every Board member. If less than a week in advance, public notice of the meeting will be given to the extent possible.

No business shall be transacted at any special meeting which does not come within the purpose(s) set forth in the call for the meeting unless there is consent of all Board members present.

If, in an emergency, a special meeting is held before the 24-hour notice can be given, each member may be asked to sign a waiver of notice. A statement regarding the time of notice and signature of such forms shall be entered in the minutes.
