SCHOOL BOARD LEGISLATIVE PROGRAM

The Board of Education must operate within the bounds of state and federal law affecting public education. If the Board is to meet its responsibilities to the community it should work vigorously for the passage of laws designated to advance the cause of good schools and seek the repeal or modifications of existing laws or regulations that impede the effective delivery of educational services. To this end, the Board will:

- 1. initiate and support action programs to improve state law affecting public education;
- 2. work for the achievement of common legislative objectives through the state and national school boards associations; and
- 3. seek both direct and indirect representation of its position on pending legislation with appropriate state and federal legislators and legislative committees.
