

ADULT EDUCATION PROGRAMS

The Board of Education shall endeavor to establish an adult education program providing the community with a broad scope of courses.

The adult education program will be administered by the Superintendent of Schools. Any fees or tuition costs related to this program will be established by the Board.

Adults will be expected to abide by the same attendance standards and discipline criteria applied to high school-age students.

Career Education

The district has limited facilities to operate an adult education career program effectively on a large scale. However, as part of the Clinton-Essex BOCES, the school district supports efforts for people to enroll in adult career education programs.
