TEXTBOOK SELECTION AND ADOPTION

The Board of Education has the responsibility of designating the textbooks to be used in the school. It will base its choice of textbooks on the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools who may involve appropriate supervisory, teaching staff members and the district=s Curriculum Committee in the selection of textbooks as he deems appropriate.

Texts, once approved by the Board, shall not be superseded for a period of five years, except by a three-fourth's vote of the Board.

The textbooks recommended for adoption will support the best current instructional methods and be consistent with the curriculum established for the school.

The Board will furnish textbooks to all students attending its school. Children who are residents of the district and attend non-public school or private schools will be loaned textbooks designated for use by the Board.
