

TEACHER AIDES AND ASSISTANTS

The Board of Education may employ teachers' aides to assist in the instructional process where needed. The process for justifying the need for a teacher aide will be established by the Superintendent of Schools. The Board shall act on the recommendation of the Superintendent based upon:

1. individual student need in the classroom;
2. cost effectiveness; and
3. the additional effectiveness in the program of instruction.

Teachers' aides do not provide direct instruction but work under the supervision of a sponsor teacher.
