MAKEUP OPPORTUNITIES

The Board of Education recognizes that there are legitimate circumstances which may prevent a student from submitting required work on time. Students who are absent shall be given reasonable time to make up assignments missed during their absence. When necessary and applicable, assignments may be sent home and teachers shall be available to render necessary assistance.

A student whose misconduct is directly related to his or her academic performance (e.g.,plagiarism) or whose absence from class is determined to be unexcused (e.g., skipping class) may be denied the opportunity to make up work.

It is the student's responsibility to request all makeup assignments from subject teachers following absence from class. The student must request assignments early enough to allow adequate time for completion prior to the end of the marking quarter.
