## Schroon Lake Central Board Policy Valedictorian and Salutatorian Effective September 2013

## **Qualifications**

Qualifications that must be met before **a** student can be a candidate for Valedictorian or Salutatorian are as follows:

- 1. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian shall meet Schroon Lake Central School graduation requirements.
- 2. The student must have been enrolled for at least four years and graduated with their entering ninth grade class. (Internships included as enrolled in SLCS)
- 3. Any student who has disciplinary action taken against him or her in the last four years for a Level 4 as outlined in District Policy will be disqualified from Valedictorian/Salutatorian status.
- 4. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian shall have the highest two averages. Averages are calculated by:
  - a. Multiplying any college course grade by a factor of 1.15 (This weights those courses 15% more than other courses.)
  - b. This total is added to the grades achieved in the regular coursework and divided by the number of credits earned.
  - c. Grades from the Freshman year through the third quarter of the Senior year, along with any accelerated class from the 8th grade year are considered.

## **Implementation Guidelines**

Using the aforementioned requirements, the top 20% of students with the highest adjusted GP A will be given the opportunity to verify their grades and college classes taken and completed. Then the adjusted GPA will be verified by two administrators and /or councilors appointed by the Superintendent.

- 1. The student with the highest GPA shall be appointed Valedictorian.
- 2. The student with the second highest GPA shall be appointed Salutatorian.
- 3. Students with equal GP A's will be given equal status.
- 4. If more than one Valedictorian or Salutatorian is appointed, the individual who will speak at graduation will be chosen by the senior class. If such ballot results in a tie, a panel of five teachers appointed by the Superintendent will cast silent ballots to determine the speaker.
