STUDENT FUND RAISING ACTIVITIES

Fund-raising projects in which students canvass the public, off school grounds, in connection with school-connected money-raising activities, will be kept to a minimum.

Students may solicit funds for school-sponsored charitable, non-profit, nonpolitical organizations with prior approval of the Superintendent of Schools.

Additional, secondary school students may solicit funds for school sponsored clubs and organizations that are raising funds to support the activities of the club or organization in the school building only with prior approval of the Student Council and the Superintendent.

Fund-raising for non-school purposes by any one individual will not be permitted on school grounds.

All moneys collected must be accounted for in strict accordance with procedures established by the business office and deposited with the Activities Treasurer.
