STUDENT VOLUNTEERS FOR SCHOOL AND PUBLIC SERVICE

The Board of Education encourages the use of student volunteers in the education program {e.g. student libraries, student office helpers, etc.) and in useful community services. However, student volunteers must be capable of carrying out their additional load without endangering their academic achievement. Therefore, all student volunteers shall be expected to maintain their grades, attend all classes, and recognize that the activity to which they are volunteering their services is secondary to their primary goal of getting an education.

Teachers and members of the community are encouraged to check with the guidance counselor and the Superintendent of Schools before students are sought for volunteer help, to make sure that the students can afford academically to undertake the additional responsibility.

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
